African Jim

Hodges Media Center / Videocassette PN1997.A2788 1998

Jim leaves rural South Africa to find work in Johannesburg and ends up finding romance and a successful career.

Cry, the Beloved Country

Hodges Media Center / Videocassette PR6031.A757C79 1992

This is a story of two men, two fathers, one black, one white, drawn together through one father's search for a lost son.

Dakan

Hodges Media Center / Videocassette PN1995.9.F67D35 1997

Dakan is the first feature film on homosexuality from sub-Saharan Africa. It also is a contemporary African reinterpretation of the age-old Romeo and Juliet conflict between love and social convention.

Generations of Resistance
