### **Databases**

#### **[America's Historical Newspapers](#)** 1690-1922

Early American newspapers published between 1690 and 1922, including titles from all 50 present states. This collection is comprised of *Early American Newspapers, Series I, II and III*.

#### **[American Memory](#)**

Created by the Library of Congress, a multi-media collection of primary source materials on the history and culture of the U. S.

**[Anthropological Index of the Royal Anthropological Institute](#)** 1970-  
ethnography, ethnology (especially European), ethnomusicology, anthropology, archaeology, linguistics

#### **[Anthropology Plus](#)** 1880s -

Contains over 800,000 records from two major databases: **Anthropological Literature** (Harvard University) and the United Kingdom's **Anthropological Index**. The comprehensive international resource for anthropology / archaeology.

#### **[Art Full Text](#)** 1984+

Includes citations and some full-text articles from art-related periodicals. Select *Art Full Text* on the menu and then select "Basic Search" or "Advanced Search." *Limited to 4 simultaneous users.* **Click on "exit program" to end your session.**

#### **[Art Index Retrospective](#)** 1929 - 1984

Bibliographic access to art-related periodicals.

#### **[ATLA Religion Database](#)** 1949+

Indexes journal articles and scholarly essays on world religions and religious perspectives on social issues. *Limited to one simultaneous user.* **Click "exit" to end your session.**

#### **[Early American Imprints, Series I: Evans, 1639-1800](#)**

Based on Charles Evans' *American Bibliography*, the definitive resource for life in 17th and 18th century America, from agriculture through foreign affairs, literature, music, religion, the Revolutionary War, witchcraft, etc. This digital collection includes full-text books, pamphlets, broadsides, and other imprints.

### **[Early American Imprints, Series II: Shaw-Shoemaker, 1801-1819](#)**

Shaw, Ralph R. and Shoemaker, Richard H. Based on the distinguished bibliography, covering every aspect of American life, this primary source collection provides full-text access to the 36,000 American books, pamphlets and broadsides published in the first nineteen years of the 19th century
