

## **2005-2006 Instructional Services Goals**

### **Instructional Web Presence:**

- Redesign web pages for instruction.
- Update and continue developing The Teaching Library

### **Marketing Instructional Services and Resources:**

- Promote Teaching Library on campus (GTAs and faculty)
- Collaborate with the RIS Outreach Council to market Instructional Services & Information Literacy
- “Point of need IL” – develop and/or market the instructional aspects of reference interactions
- Develop marketing strategies within departments and on campus
- Make sure Instructional Services has a presence in RIS, Subject Librarian, and Library Representative meetings

### **Campus Instructor Support:**

- Build on last spring’s half day workshop on building/creating library assignments (target audience - new faculty and GTAs)
- More faculty focus groups and/or workshops regarding instruction

### **Teaching Librarian Support:**

- Teaching Interest Group – revitalize
- Organize workshop/conference or TLA pre-conference for UT and East TN librarians on Library Instruction & Information Literacy.
- Pursue/explore professional development opportunities that focus on IL.

### **Instructional Services Program Updates:**

#### Workshops

- Develop grid method for workshop series planning
- New promotional handouts for each workshop (with linked pdfs)
- Develop a series of core workshops that will be offered 3-4 times each semester

#### First Year Studies

- Make contacts within the program
- Develop materials for integration into Fall 2006 course materials, and training for instructors and peer mentors for Spring 2005.

#### Communication Studies

- Revise the Fall 2005 materials for Spring 2006
