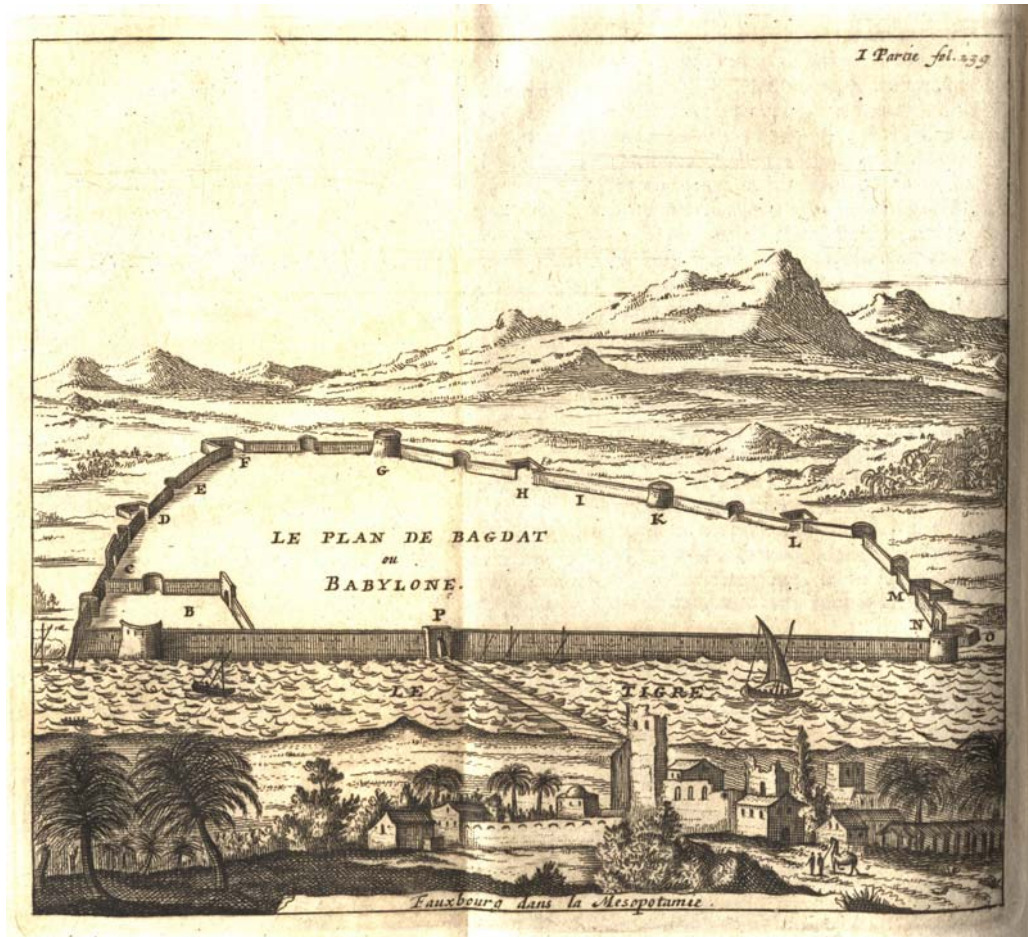


# WORLD RELIGIONS: ISLAM AND BAHAIISM

Following is a list of titles, presented in chronological order, relating to Bahaiism, Islam, and Islamic culture. These are titles held uniquely (among the University Libraries) in the Special Collections Library, in the editions and formats cited. The earliest titles represent the historic record of the travels of persons from western cultures into the lands where Islamic culture prevails, or their investigation of Islam itself.

At a time when the study of Islam and Islamic history and culture is of pressing topical interest, as well as in the interest of the routine study of Islam by scholars, we hope that the availability of the materials listed here will prove enriching to the inquiry of both students and faculty.
