Summons, dated Knoxville, May 29, 1794, calling Samuel Newell to appear in a matter concerning the estate of Solomon Marks.

Although the Special Collections Library is not known as a significant repository of Judaica, the manuscript holdings in the papers of Tennessee personalities and families include collections that relate to Jewish Tennesseans. And the book collection includes interesting titles connected with Jewish life and religion in America and, particularly, in Tennessee.
