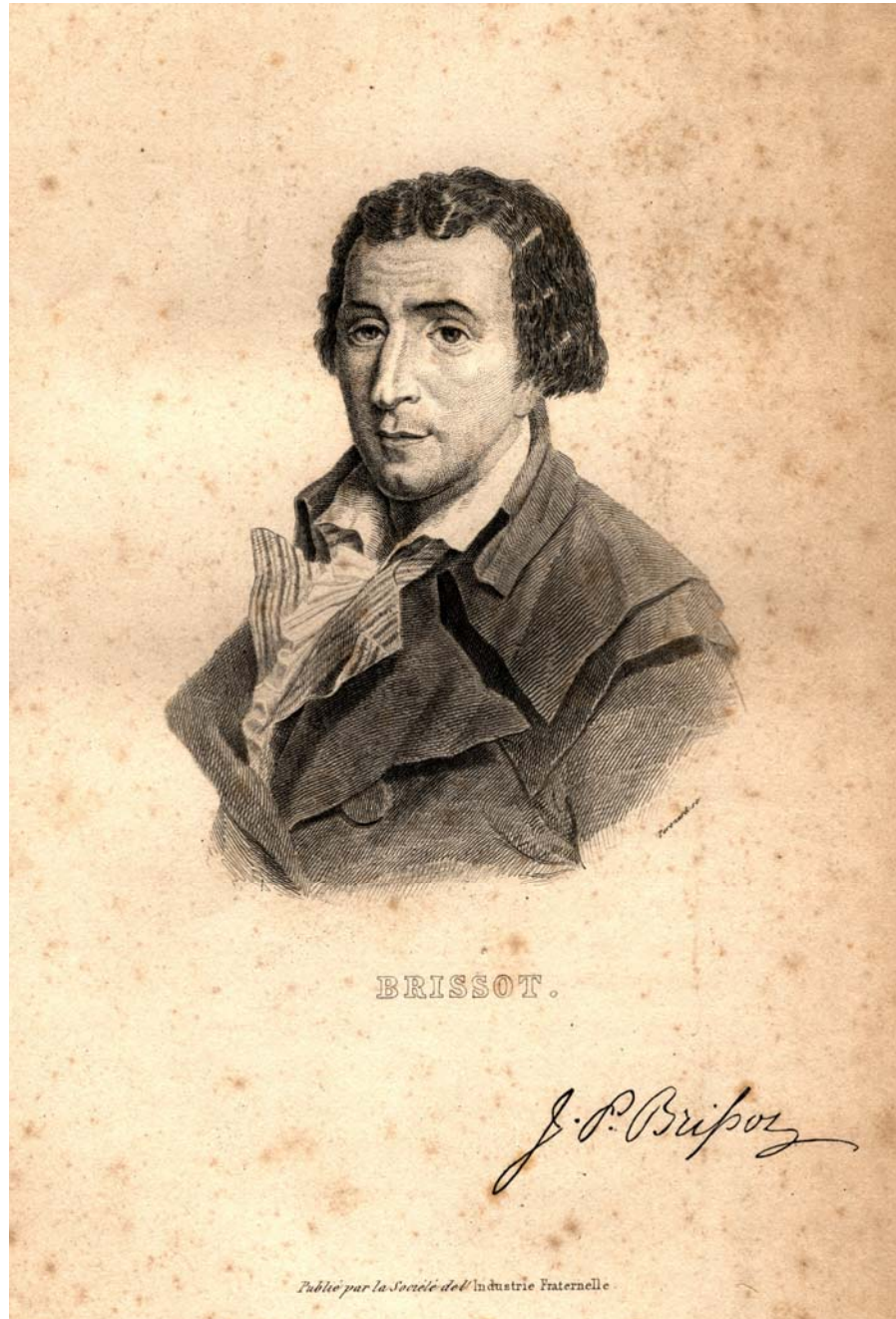


JOURNALISM AND JOURNALISTS

This research guide highlights a selection of materials in the Special Collections Library’s holdings, relating to the field of journalism and to individual personalities in the profession. The growing body of papers in the manuscript collections, as well as titles from book and printed ephemera collections, provide insight into an endeavor at the very heart of American democracy. Journalism in the British Isles and Europe is represented, as well.

Excluded from this listing are, among other titles, books found in both the Special Collections Library and the circulating collections of Hodges Library. Books by and about listed modern journalists and author journalists are omitted, as well, as they are perhaps more familiar and easily accessible than materials in non-standard formats. Scholars interested in the history of printing in the United States will find additional state-by-state accounts listed under the author Douglas Crawford McMurtrie in the ALEPH catalog; newspaper publishers are among those listed in these histories.

The entries are arranged by topic and listed alphabetically within each topical division. Finding aids to manuscript collections listed are available under “Manuscripts” on the Special Collections Library’s web page (<http://www.lib.utk.edu/spcoll/>).

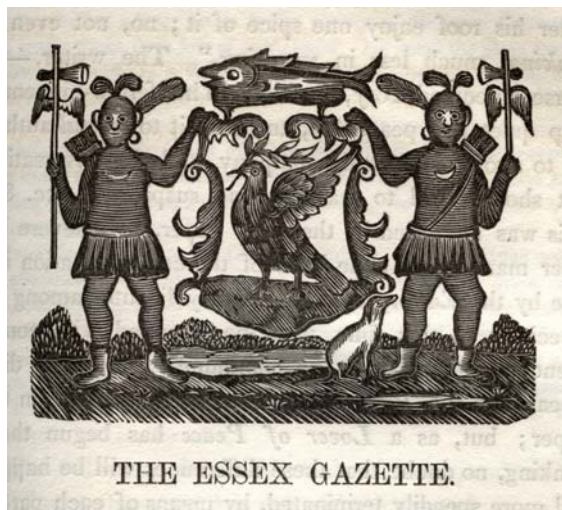

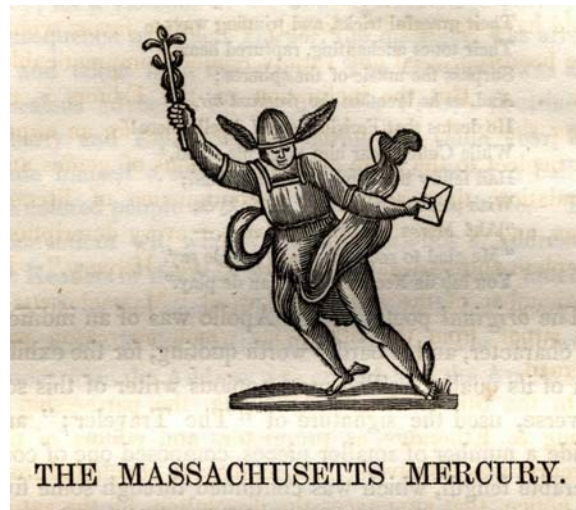
