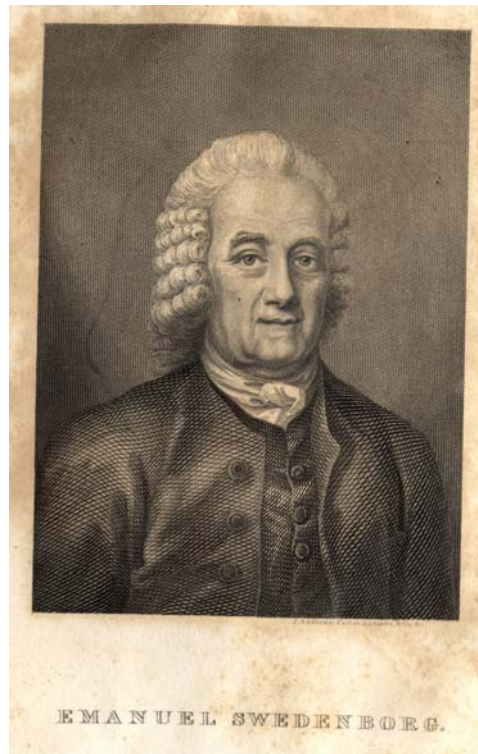


RELIGION IN AMERICA: VARIOUS COMMUNITIES

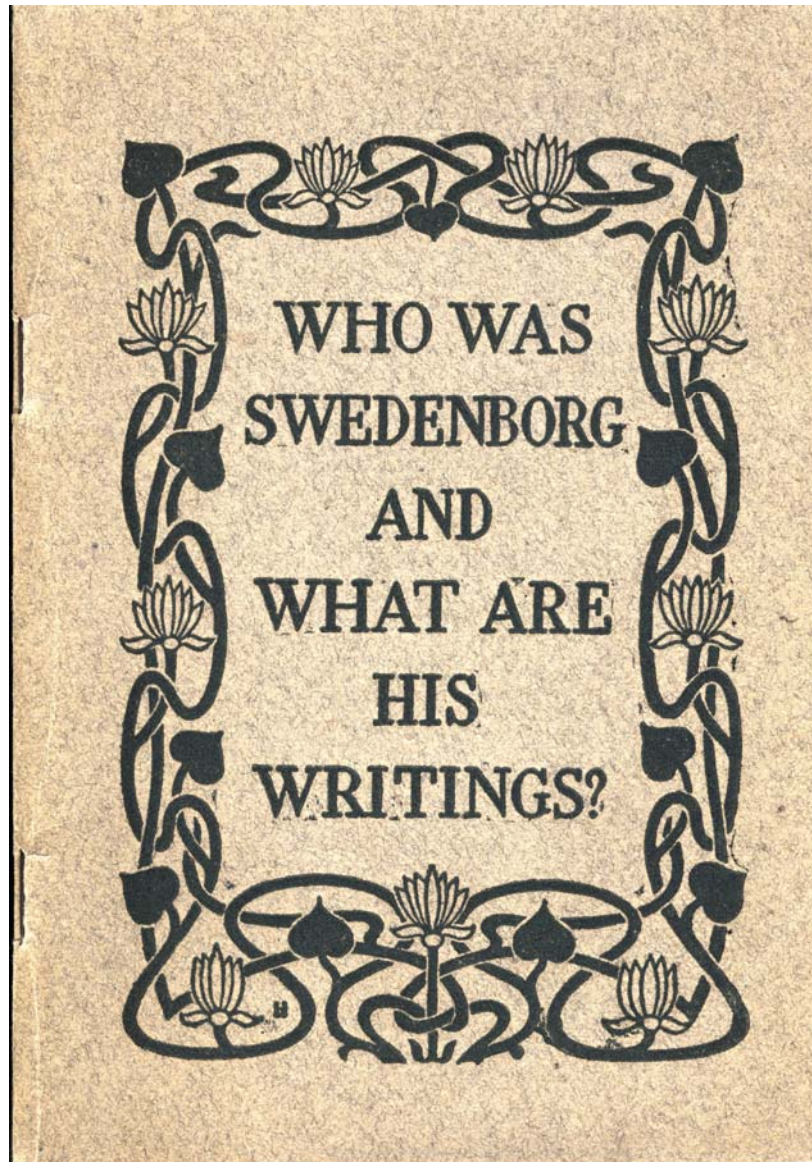
