

RAILROADS AND URBAN TRANSIT

Following is a selection of materials relating, in one way or another, to railroads and urban transit systems. These are drawn from the book, manuscript, and newspapers and printed ephemera collections of the Special Collections Library and are materials held exclusively, amongst all the University Libraries' collections, in Special Collections.

Titles listed in the "General" subdivision of the Railroads section of this guide may apply broadly to railroads and aspects of railroad business and law, or may include information about a variety of particular railroad companies, so that scholars investigating the history of a particular railroad company may find information, not solely among the titles devoted to that particular railroad, but also among the materials in a manuscript collection listed in the "General" subdivision of this guide. In addition, the listing includes titles in the field of literature, in which railroads and railroading figure prominently.

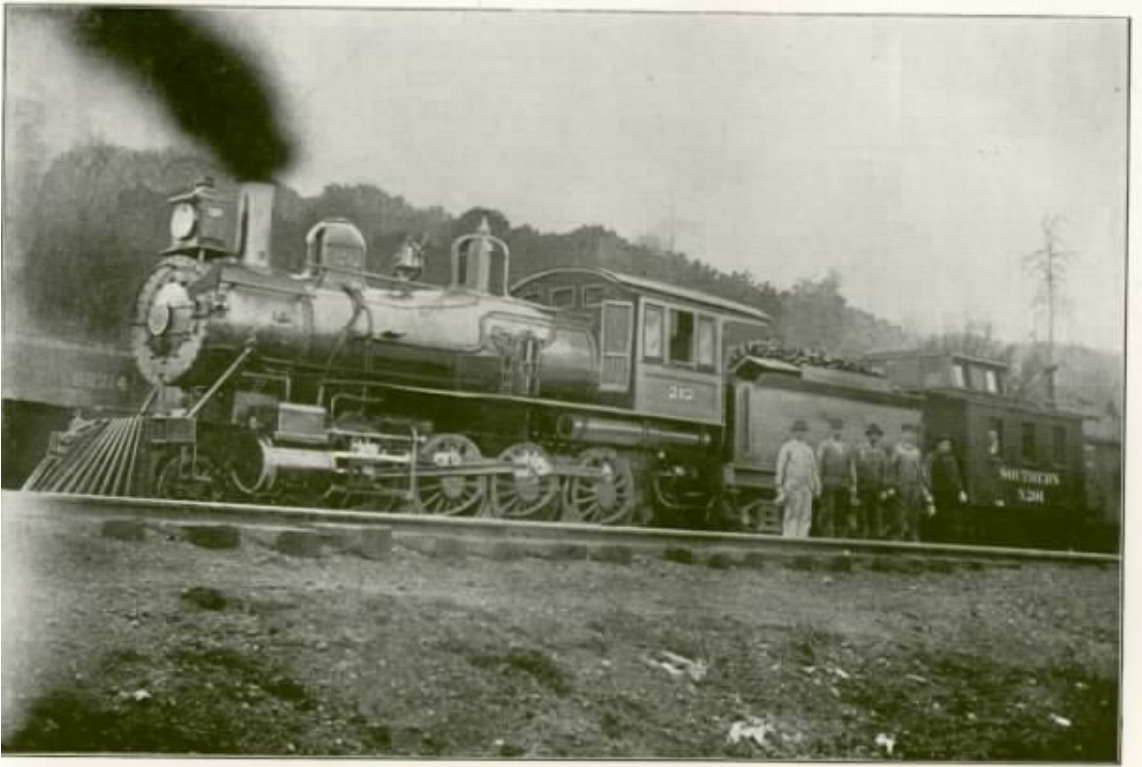
