- **Professional Development**-Promote professional development and foster educational opportunities and excellence for the TNGIC membership and the geospatial community.



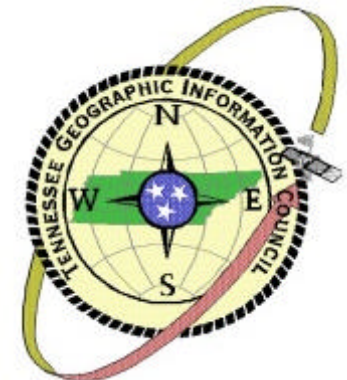

The Tennessee Geographic Information Council (TNGIC) first gathered in Murfreesboro, Tennessee in 1993. This initial meeting provided the foundation for TNGIC to formally establish itself as a non-profit group and adopt a set of by-laws that summarize its mission. TNGIC is governed by a board of directors. Membership is open to anyone with a desire to learn about the geographic community. TNGIC has grown into a professional organization of over 275 members across the state and in many areas of GIS use and interest.

TNGIC hosts an annual meeting, offering pre-conference training as well as two days of workshops, presentations and vendor displays. Members receive a quarterly newsletter as well as access to the TNGIC list server. In 2001 we introduced regional meetings, a one day meeting with workshops and presentations in each region of the state.
